IV. THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and Athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.

VII. ENTRIES

- Sponsored show rules apply to this event.
- Classes 4 & 10 will start with normal clear round riders going not against the clock, and then with Under 14 years old riders going against the clock. U14 riders must submit proof of age if they wish to enter this section.
- Classes 5 & 6 will run over the same course in two different sections. The first section will be Table A against the clock, and the second section will be for Junior riders Under 18 years old with a second different round. U18 riders are only allowed 1 horse and must submit proof of age if they wish to enter this section.
- Riders eligible for both the Juniors Championship (U18) and the Grand Prix are only allowed to enter one of these competitions.
- Class 9 is open to all horses, ridden horses will go first then riders on foot will follow.
- Class 12 will have normal individual classification and a bonus prize for the top 3 teams. Teams must comprise of 3 members.
- A declaration of the Grand Prix horse must be made with the entries before the first Big competition.
