IV. THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

- 1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
- 2. Horses and Athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
- 3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
- 4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.

VII. ENTRIES

IMPORTANT

- Sponsored 3* show rules apply to this event.
- Riders with more than one horse in Classes 3,4,7,8,13 must declare one horse for points.
- No H/C rounds are accepted.
- Riders have till before the start of the last class of the day to declare their classes for the following day, except rider/combination in the last class of the day have 30mins after the last class to declare.
- Civil I.D. copy is required for riders U-16 in Class 10 and U-21 in Class 12
- Class 11 will have normal individual classification and a bonus prize for the top 3 teams.
 Teams must comprise of 4 members.
- Class 9 will be groups of 4 by a draw and if 1 rider left will be added with the last group.
- Riders joining the 80cm can't join any other class.
- Championship:
- The Big Tour will be a championship.
- Day 1 Table C, Day 2 Special Two Phases, & Day 3 Two Rounds and best 50% results will qualify to the 2nd round
- Riders will collect points during Day 1 and Day 2, after that it will be added and subtracted from the first place points and then divide it by 2. For example: Rider A has 50 Points and Rider B has 48 Points. (Rider A 50 Points Rider B 48 Points)/2= (2)/2= 1 fault. So, rider A will start Day 3 carrying 0 faults and Rider B carrying 1 fault.
- Every rider planning to do the championship must **declare** the horse the horse they're doing the championship with.
- If the rider doesn't declare even though they are only riding one horse, they won't get points for that day.
- If non-Kuwaiti riders are placed, the points will go to the next placed rider.
- If a rider/horse combination not declared and was placed, the points will go to the next placed rider/horse combination declared.
- Day 1 Start List will be random thru the system.
- Riders with two horses in Day 1 the declared horse will go first.
- Day 2 Start List will start with the championship rider/horse combination according to their rankings of day 1, then the non-Kuwaiti riders and Kuwaiti rider/horse combination that are not planning to do the championship.
- Riders/horse combination who are doing the championship are allowed after day 2 to move to the 135cm class.
