IV. THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

- 1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
- 2. Horses and Athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
- 3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
- 4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.

VII. ENTRIES

IMPORTANT

- Updated two day sponsored show rules apply to this event.
- Riders entering the 60cm (Class 1) are not allowed to enter any other class during the event except for Class 10.
- Riders with more than one horse in Classes 4, 5 and 8 must declare one horse for points. Failure to do so will result in the worst result to be counted.
- Jumping riders entering Class 10 must be under 18 years old. They can only enter once.
- One of the runners or bikers in Class 10 must be a competing rider during the event. They can only be entered once.
- Only top 6 teams will be rewarded.
- The separate categories in Classes 2 and 6 will have a separate awarding ceremony.
- Civil I.D. copy is required for riders entering the age restricted categories as well as Class 10. Please submit Civil I.D. copy with the entries.


